

FROM YOUR BOARD PRESIDENT

Despite numerous appeals in person, in writing, by telephone, by e-mails, by mail, by door-hangers, articles in this publication, and several extensions



an inadequate number of ballots for the Deed Restriction change mailed out on February 3rd were returned. Your Board came to the conclusion that any further extension or appeals were pointless, and we declared the poll closed and the ballot initiative VOID. None of the ballots that were returned would be opened.

As my wife will attest, I am generally a positive person. But this has me upset. My personal belief is that the primary cause for your fellow shareholders not returning their ballots is due to one thing apathy. One definition of apathy is "a lack of interest in or concern for things that others find moving or exciting". How can someone live in a community like Casa Loma, have friends and neighbors in that community, have a financial investment in that community, and not care about that community? If a shareholder didn't agree with the proposal they should vote "No". If they agree, they should vote "Yes". Either way they should return their ballot. To not respond at all means they just don't care.

Some have suggested that this lack of concern is because of the actions or inactions of previous boards. That may be true. My wife and I have been residents of Casa Loma since 2015 and we have heard all sorts of rumors and stories about things being done or not being done. It has been my experience in life that well half over of what people hear is not fully based in fact or truth. That being said, I have to admit that I was initially reluctant to become involved in Casa Loma's Board of Directors because of these rumors and stories. As I continued to think about it, however, I came to the conclusion that unless concerned, dedicated, and qualified people become involved on the Casa Loma board and the various committees nothing would get better.

I truly believe that the makeup of the current board embodies the concern, dedication, and qualification that this community has needed, and all of us are trying to look forward rather than backwards. Will you please join us? Get concerned! Get involved! Ask to serve! Come to the monthly Board Meetings! They are held on the second Tuesday following the first Monday of each month at 6:30 PM. The next meeting will be on June 15th.


MISDIRECTED MAIL OR PACKAGE?

WHAT CAN BE INCLUDED FOR GARBAGE PICKUP IN MANATEE COUNTY?



Last month we gave you a list of what items are acceptable for Recycling in Manatee County. This month, rather than list the things that can be included in your bi-weekly garbage pickup it would be easier to list what can NOT be included.

- First anything listed last month that should be recycled.
- HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE: Solvents, Paint, Stain, Varnish, Used Oil, Pesticides, Household Chemicals, Ammunition, Aerosols (non empty), Antifreeze, Automotive batteries, Cleaning compounds, Fertilizers, Fluorescent bulbs, Gas or Diesel Fuel, Herbicides, Weed Killer, Insecticides, Propane Tanks and Rechargeable Batteries. TAKE THESE ITEMS TO THE LENA ROAD LANDFILL (SEE BELOW FOR DAYS AND HOURS).
- WHITE GOODS: Appliances, Refrigerators, Washing Machines, Dryers, Stoves, Freezers, and Water Heaters. Call Manatee County Utilities Customer Service at (941) 792-8811 for pickup.
- E-SCRAP: This is consumer electronic equipment that is no longer wanted. Examples are TV's, Computers, Laptops, Microwave Ovens, Battery Chargers, Cell Phones & Cords, CD Players/Recorders, Circuit Boards, Copiers, DVD Players/Recorders, Fax Machines, Game Hardware, Hard Drives, Keyboards, Personal Audio Systems, Printers, Radios, Scanners. Monitors and VCR's. THESE ITEMS CAN EITHER BE TAKEN TO THE LENA ROAD LANDFILL OR YOU CAN ARRANGE FOR PICKUP FOR A FEE BY CALLING (941) 792-8811.
- BIO-HAZARDOUS MATERIAL: Sharps, Absorbent Items (Gauze, Cotton, Bandages, etc.) that are saturated with blood or regulated body fluids.
- MEDICINE: You may take non-liquid medications (pills and inhalers only) to:

- o 407 57th Ave E, Bradenton, Monday Friday, 8:00 am 4:00 pm.
- o 616 67th St Circle E, Bradenton, Monday Friday, 8:00 am 4:00 pm.

DO NOT place medication in the recycle bin, give it to someone else, flush it down the toilet, or put it in the trash without disguising the drugs, as human or animal scavengers may find and misuse them.

- ✓ Keep matches and lighters out of reach from children.



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
